The human calender starts at the year 0, which is the date when humans first arrived in Hurssia from Ardinnia. The Old Hurssian calender, as used by the elves and dwarves splits the years into lunar ages. These are determined by the positioning of the moons, sun and planet. Each age is 2500 years long. Humans arrived in Hurssia at the very beginning of the 5th age.
